Subject: Intergovernmental Agreement between Maricopa County and the City of Mesa

Purpose and Recommendation

The City of Mesa Police Department is respectfully requesting that the Mesa City Council authorize the City Manager or his designee to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement between Maricopa County, on behalf of Maricopa County Adult Probation Department and the City of Mesa, on behalf of the Mesa Police Department.

Background

The purpose of this agreement is to enhance public safety in the community through cooperative efforts between Adult Probation and the Mesa Police Department.

Discussion

Under this Agreement, the Adult Probation Warrant Unit agrees to assign at least one full-time probation officer to the Mesa Police Department Street Crimes Unit in order to facilitate joint crime fighting efforts and arrest of individuals with active probation warrants. Adult Probation and the Mesa Police Department will work together to identify priorities, taking into consideration the powers and duties permitted by an Adult Probation Officer.

Fiscal Impact

Under this Agreement, each agency will be responsible for payroll expenses of their respective personnel. All travel and training will be the responsibility of the parent agency.


The Mesa Police Department will provide the Probation Officer(s) assigned to the Police Department workspace to facilitate the activities covered by this Agreement.

Alternative

If declined, the Intergovernmental Agreement between Adult Probation and the Mesa Police Department will not be signed. The community will not receive the public safety benefits of the cooperative effort.

Concurrence





A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE TO EXECUTE AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN MARICOPA COUNTY, ON BEHALF OF MARICOPA COUNTY ADULT PROBATION AND THE CITY OF MESA, ON BEHALF OF THE MESA POLICE DEPARTMENT.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Approving an Intergovernmental Agreement between Maricopa County, on behalf of Maricopa County Adult Probation Department and the City of Mesa, on behalf of the Mesa Police Department.

Section 2: Authorizing and directing the City Manager, or his designated representative, to execute the Agreement on behalf of the City of Mesa, and authorizing the City Clerk to attest to the signature of the City Manager thereon.
