**Subject:** Intergovernmental Agreement between the Maricopa County Sheriff's Office and the City of Mesa

### Purpose and Recommendation

The City of Mesa Police Department is respectfully requesting that the Mesa City Council approve an Intergovernmental Agreement between the Maricopa County Sheriff's Office and the City of Mesa and authorize the City Manager or his designee to execute the Agreement. Under this Agreement, the Maricopa County Sheriff's Office will reimburse up to \$30,000 for officer overtime.

### Background

The Maricopa County Sheriff's Office has received federal funding through Community Oriented Policing Services, Methamphetamine Initiative. This funding will be passed through to the Mesa Police Department for ongoing investigations.

### Discussion

Methamphetamine Initiative Grants are used to help communities combat the manufacture, use, and distribution of methamphetamine and in the prevention and treatment of methamphetamine abuse. These grants are responsible for advancing community policing nationwide and supporting state, local and tribal law enforcement agencies.

**Fiscal Impact**

Mesa Police Department personnel will be responsible for submitting invoices on a monthly basis to the Maricopa County Sheriff's Office. The Maricopa County Sheriff's Office will remit monies due upon receipt of the invoices.


**Alternative**


If this Agreement is declined, the Mesa Police Department will be limited in our ability to conduct methamphetamine investigations.





A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE MARICOPA COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE AND THE CITY OF MESA AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE TO EXECUTE THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT. THIS AGREEMENT WILL REIMBURSE UP TO \$30,000 FOR OFFICER OVERTIME.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Approving an Intergovernmental Agreement between the Maricopa County Sheriff's Office and the City of Mesa and authorizing the City Manager or his designated representative to execute the Intergovernmental Agreement. This Agreement will reimburse up to \$30,000 for officer overtime.

Section 2: Authorizing and directing the City Manager, or his designated representative, to execute the Agreement on behalf of the City of Mesa, and authorizing the City Clerk to attest to the signature of the City Manager thereon.
