Subject: Purchase of One Regenerative Air Street Sweeper (Addition to the Fleet) for the Transportation Department, Field Operations (Fully Funded through MAG and Mesa's Federal Environmental Compliance Fee) **(Single Bid)** ((Mesa Contract #2008208) "Citywide" contract

Purpose and Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the purchase of One Regenerative Air Street Sweeper as recommended. Bid pricing was obtained and evaluated by the Transportation and Business Services Departments.

The Business Services Department recommends awarding the contract to the lowest, responsive and responsible bidder, Balar Equipment Corporation at \$215,311.23, including applicable sales tax.

Background/Discussion

This sweeper, which is PM-10 certified, will be utilized to maintain city streets and other city-owned asphalt surfaces free of debris.

The Maricopa Association of Governments (MAG) is providing \$189,724.00 (88% of the total cost) for this street sweeper purchase. The remaining balance of \$25,587.23 is available through Mesa's Federal Environmental Compliance Fee, which is currently a \$2.00 fee assessed monthly to all utility customers.

Twenty-five (25) vendors were invited to bid, in addition to advertisements in the East Valley Tribune, Arizona Republic, Record Reporter and Bid Net. Thirteen vendors downloaded the bid from Purchasing's Internet site; however, only two vendors submitted a bid in December 2008. One of those bids was deemed to be non-responsive as it did not meet specifications.

Alternatives

Council may choose not to authorize this purchase and new bids would be obtained.

Fiscal Impact

The total amount of \$215,311.23 is available in Fleet Services' budget utilizing Federal Environmental Compliance Fee Revenue for Street Sweeping in the amount of \$25,587.23 and reimbursement of \$189,714.00 from MAG through a Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement (CMAQ) Grant.




