## City Council Report

**Subject:** Contract Amendment between the City of Mesa and the Pima County Sheriff's Department

### Purpose and Recommendation

The City of Mesa Police Department is respectfully requesting that the Mesa City Council authorize the City Manager or his designee to approve a Contract Amendment with the Pima County Sheriff's Department. This Contract Amendment provides an additional \$12,868.30 to purchase mobile radios.

### Background

In 2005, the Office of National Drug Control Policy allocated funds to member agencies of the Arizona Southwest Border High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area Program. The Pima County Sheriff's Department acted as the administrator of these funds.

The original award, in the amount of \$10,085, expired in September 2006 and all funds were expended. However, additional funds to purchase radio equipment in the amount of \$12,868.30 have been allocated through a Contract Amendment by the Pima County Sheriff's Department. The Contract Amendment also extends the termination date to June 30, 2009.

### Discussion

The Mesa Police Department provides one officer to the Arizona WANTED Task Force Initiative. The Arizona WANTED Task Force is comprised of US Marshals, Maricopa County Adult Probation, Arizona Department of Public Safety, Tempe Police Department and Mesa Police Department personnel. The purpose of the Task Force is to apprehend outstanding fugitives across the East Valley.

The Mesa Police Department will purchase portable radios and distribute them to Arizona WANTED Task Force officers. Issuing radios to Task Force officers will alleviate inadequate communication among the officers who work throughout the East Valley on a daily basis.

## **Fiscal Impact**


Mesa Police Department personnel will be responsible for invoicing the Pima County Sheriff's Department once the radios have been purchased.

## **Alternative**

If the Contract Amendment is declined, the funds will not be accepted and the officers on the Arizona WANTED Task Force will not have adequate communication with one another.

## **Concurrence**







WHEREAS, CONTRACTOR and COUNTY, pursuant to Article I - Term, have agreed to extend the Contract term for a period of 36 months;

WHEREAS, CONTRACTOR and COUNTY, pursuant to Article 4, have agreed to increase the contract amount to allow payment for the continued provision of HIDTA 15 during the extended term of the contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed as follows:

**CHANGE: ARTICLE I - TERM:**

From: "... shall terminate on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2006..."

To: "... shall terminate on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2009..."

**CHANGE: ARTICLE IV - PAYMENT:**

From: "Total payment for this Contract shall not exceed \$10,085.00."

To: "Total payment for this Contract shall not exceed \$22,953.30."

The effective date of this Amendment shall be July 01, 2006.

All other provisions of the Contract, not specifically changed by this Amendment, shall remain in effect and be binding upon the parties.
