Subject: Purchase of Ten (10) Digital Portable Radios for the Police Department (Contract #P-7288-05) (Fully Funded HIDTA Federal Grant Program) "Citywide" contract

Purpose and Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the Purchase of Ten (10) Digital Portable Radios as recommended. Contract pricing was evaluated by the Police and Business Services Departments.

The Business Services Department recommends authorizing purchase from the cooperative contract with Motorola at \$53,447.47, including applicable Mesa sales tax.

Funding is available from the High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) Grant Program, a drug-prohibition enforcement program through the U.S. Office of National Drug Control Policy, and must be used while the funding is made available or forfeited.

Background/Discussion

This purchase will provide communications radios to be used by Police personnel in conjunction with the U.S. Marshall Task Force to reduce illicit drug use, manufacturing and trafficking, drug-related crime and violence, and drug-related health consequences. The radios will be programmed with multi-agency frequencies to allow for seamless communications by Taskforce members throughout the Phoenix Metropolitan area.

These radios will be purchased off the City of Phoenix cooperative contract to obtain the most favorable pricing available in today's market.

Alternatives


Council may choose not to authorize purchase from the City of Phoenix contract and new bids would be obtained.


