Subject: Purchase of an Early Intervention Database Software for the Police Department, Internal Affairs (Fully Funded Asset Forfeiture [RICO] Funds) (Contract #2009131) (Single Proposer) "Citywide" contract

Purpose and Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the Purchase of an Early Intervention Database Software as recommended. Proposal pricing was obtained and evaluated by the Police and Business Services Departments.

The Business Services Department recommends awarding the contract to CI Technologies, Inc. at \$46,675.20, including applicable use tax.

Background/Discussion

This purchase will provide database software that will be used by the Internal Affairs (IA) Section of the Police Department to investigate, document, track and analyze data obtained through investigation and community contacts. Internal Affairs is in need of a technological upgrade for data entry, recordkeeping and workflow management. The existing database systems are inadequate and inefficient as they require repetitive data entry, which is cumbersome and may create errors and omissions. This new database will provide an accurate, efficient means to track sworn and civilian staff behavior and incidents in a timely manner, which will allow for early notice and intervention when necessary to prevent negative ramifications.

Three (3) vendors were invited to submit a proposal, in addition to advertisements in the Arizona Republic, East Valley Tribune, Record Reporter and Bid Net. Seventeen (17) vendors downloaded the bid from Purchasing's Internet site; however, only one proposer responded.

Alternatives


Council may choose not to award this contract and new proposals will be obtained.

Fiscal Impact




