

Working with the Police

What number do I call?

Call **9-1-1** if it **IS** a life-threatening emergency or a crime in progress.

Call **644-2211** if it **IS NOT** a life threatening emergency, you need an officer, and to report suspicious activity. You would also call this number to file a police report.

Call **644-2324** for general information or questions about the Mesa Police Department.

What do I need to tell them when I call?

- **WHAT** happened
- **WHEN** did it happen
- **WHERE** did it happen
- **WHO** did it

Give a suspect and/or vehicle description, if you have one.

Suspect:

- Race/Sex
- Clothing worn
- Height/Weight
- Hair Color/Style/Length
- Other identifying marks/traits

Vehicle:

- Color
- Make/Model/Year
- License plate number
- Direction of travel
- Other identifying features

Do I have to give my name, address or phone number?

No; however, it is helpful to have that information in case we need to re-contact you for additional information.

Will the officer stop and talk to me?

Not unless you specifically request it. If you want to speak with the officer, tell the dispatcher when you call in. Many times the dispatcher will ask if you want the officer to stop by and speak with you.
