

4. PURPOSE AND NEED FOR ACTION (Identify decision to be made and need date) To facilitate closure and early redevelopment of the former AFRL Mesa by the LRA, even prior to totally vacating the installation no later than 15 September 2011.		
5. DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED ACTION AND ALTERNATIVE (DOPAA) (Provide sufficient detail for evaluation of the total action.) The AF will lease the installation to the LRA and allow phased exclusive occupancy of the improvements as Air Force activities and personnel depart. After 15 September 2011, the LRA will have possession and beneficial use of the entire installation. The LRA will find sublessees needing secure office space for the existing buildings/facilities and will assume the cost of operating and maintaining the installation. Occupancy and use of the installation and its buildings/facilities would be virtually unchanged. The alternative is no action, in which case the installation would remain vacant and the AF would pay caretaking costs, until the LRA received the property by deed from the AF.
