2-9-1: CREATION OF BOARD:

There is hereby created a Board to be known as the Design Review Board. The Design Review Board shall be composed of seven (7) persons who are citizens and electors of the City. The members of the Board shall be appointed by the Mayor with the approval of the Council for staggered terms of three (3) years each. At the time of the initial appointment, pursuant to this Chapter, the Mayor shall designate the length of terms for each member to provide for staggered terms. No member of the Design Review Board shall serve more than two (2) complete consecutive terms; however, a member may be reappointed after the lapse of three (3) years from the end of the previous term. Continued absence of any member from meetings of the Board shall, at the discretion of the City Council, render any such member liable for immediate removal from office by the Council. Any member absent from three (3) consecutive meetings without being excused shall be considered as having vacated his appointment. The membership of the Design Review Board shall include two (2) architects, two (2) other design professionals (i.e., landscape architecture, engineering, urban planning, interior design, or other design-related backgrounds), one (1) contractor/developer, and two (2) citizens. 2-9-2: POWERS AND DUTIES:

The Design Review Board shall advise the Council on issues concerning exterior design and landscaping guidelines for buildings, structures, and open space; review and decide on design and architectural elements of development proposals as specified by ordinance; and perform such other functions as may be assigned to them by the Mayor or City Council. The Board shall elect one (1) of its members to serve as chairman, and each chairman so elected shall serve for a one- (1-) year term. (2077,3170)
