ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed bids will be received until Thursday, March 5, 2009 at 1:00p.m. All sealed bids will be received at **Mesa City Plaza Building, Engineering Department at 20 East Main Street, 5th Floor**, Mesa, Arizona; except for bids delivered 30 minutes prior to opening will be received at the information desk, 1st floor, Main Lobby of the Mesa City Plaza Building. Any bid received after the time specified will be returned without any consideration.

This contract shall be for furnishing all labor, materials, transportation and services for the construction and/or installation of the following work:

Demolition and removals, drainage structure and pipe removal, grading, excavation, embankment, installation of drainage structures and pipes, asphalt paving, pavement markings, installation of new taxiway edge lights, illuminated guidance signs, and appurtenant work for a new Aircraft Engine Run-Up Area at Runway 4R; and the establishment of three new geodetic control points per Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) and National Geodetic Survey (NGS) requirements.

A voluntary pre-bid meeting and site visit will be held for this project at Falcon Field Airport, Mesa, Arizona. See the Special Provisions for additional information.

Contractors desiring to submit proposals may purchase sets of Plans, Special Provisions and Bid Proposal from ScottBlue Reprographics at 133 West 1st Avenue, Mesa, Arizona, for a non-refundable cost of \$40.00 per set, regardless of whether the Contract Documents are returned. Copies of Contract Documents are available for viewing at the Engineering Department office. *Please call 480-644-2251 prior to arriving at the Engineering Department to ensure the documents are available for viewing (2 sets available).*

Work shall be completed within sixty (60) consecutive calendar days, beginning with the day following the starting date specified in the Notice to Proceed.

Bids must be submitted on the Proposal Form provided and be accompanied by the Bid Bond for not less than ten percent (10%) of the total bid, payable to the City of Mesa, Arizona, or a certified or cashier's check. **PERSONAL OR INDIVIDUAL SURETY BONDS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE.**

The successful bidder will be required to execute the standard form of contract for construction within ten (10) days after formal award of contract.

The successful bidder, simultaneously with the execution of the Contract, will be required to furnish a Payment Bond in the amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract Price, A Performance Bond in an amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract Price, and a Certificate of Insurance.

Additionally, this project involves Federal Grant Monies, therefore, the successful bidder shall comply with the following Federal requirements:

1. Federal Funds are being used to assist in the construction of this project and, accordingly, all applicable Federal laws must be complied with.
2. The proposed contract is under and subject to Executive Order 11246, as amended, of September 24, 1965, and to the Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) and Federal Labor Standard Provisions.
3. All labor on the project shall be paid no less than the prevailing minimum wage rates established by the U.S. Secretary of Labor and contained in the specifications and shall comply with all provisions of the Davis-Bacon Act.
4. The Bidder agrees to comply with the provisions of the State of Arizona Executive Order 75-5, dated April 28, 1975, relating to equal opportunity.
5. The Bidder must supply all information required by the bidding documents or specifications.
6. Each Bidder must complete, sign, and submit with his bid, a "Non-Collusive Bidding Certification", a "Certification of Non-Segregated Facilities," a statement entitled "Bidder's Statement on Previous Contracts Subject to EEO Clause," an "Assurance of Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Participation," a "Certification Regarding Debarment, Suspension, Ineligibility and Voluntary Exclusion," a "Certification Regarding Foreign Countries", a "Buy American Certificate" and a "Certificate of Insurability" as contained in the Contract Documents.
7. A contractor having 50 or more employees and his subcontractor having 50 or more employees and who may be awarded a contract of \$50,000 or more will be required to maintain an affirmative action program, the standards for which are contained in the specifications.
8. To be eligible for award, each Bidder must comply with the affirmative action requirements which are contained in the specifications.
9. Disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award of any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement. **A race/gender neutral goal is established for this project.**
10. Women will be afforded equal opportunity in all areas of employment. However, the employment of women shall not diminish the standards of requirements for the employment of minorities.
11. No Bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of ninety (90) calendar days after the date set for the opening thereof.

The right is hereby reserved to accept or reject any or all bids or parts thereto, to waive any informalities in any proposal and reject the bids of any persons who have been delinquent or unfaithful to any contract with the City of Mesa.
