ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed bids will be received until Thursday, February 25, 2010 at 2:30 p.m. All sealed bids will be received at **Mesa City Plaza Building, Engineering Department at 20 East Main Street, 5th Floor**, Mesa, Arizona; except for bids delivered 30 minutes prior to opening will be received at the information desk, 1st floor, Main Lobby of the Mesa City Plaza Building. Any bid received after the time specified will be returned without any consideration.

This contract shall be for furnishing all labor, materials, transportation and services for the construction and/or installation of the following work:

Remove approximately 8,100 SY of asphalt paving, scarify and re-compact aggregate base course, and install new asphalt paving consisting of 1.5 inches of rubber AC surface course over 4 inches of AC (A-3/4") base course. Uniform mill approximately 36,100 SY of existing AC pavement and overlay with 1.5 inches of new rubber AC pavement. Provide tapered mill of approximately 18,800 SY of existing AC pavement and overlay with 1.5 inches of new rubber AC pavement. Remove and replace approximately 5,000 SF of concrete. Furnish and install sidewalk ramps, survey monuments, valley gutters, sidewalk, curb and gutter, and pavement stripping per plan. Additional items of work as necessary to complete the project in accordance with the Approved Plans and Specifications.

Work shall be completed within sixty (60) consecutive calendar days

Bids must be submitted on the Proposal Form provided and be accompanied by the Bid Bond for not less than ten percent (10%) of the total bid, payable to the City of Mesa, Arizona, or a certified or cashier's check. **PERSONAL OR INDIVIDUAL SURETY BONDS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE. The following forms are to be submitted with the Bid Proposal for Federal-Aid Projects.**

- 1. Surety (Bid) Bond**
- 2. Non-Collusion Bidding Certification (See Proposal Documents and Forms)**
- 3. Certification with regard to performance of previous contracts**

The successful bidder will be required to execute the standard form of contract for construction within ten (10) days after formal award of contract.

The successful bidder, simultaneously with the execution of the Contract, will be required to furnish a Payment Bond in the amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract Price, a Performance Bond in an amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract Price, and a Certificate of Insurance.

The right is hereby reserved to accept or reject any or all bids or parts thereto, to waive any informalities in any proposal and reject the bids of any persons who have been delinquent or unfaithful to any contract with the City of Mesa.
