Subject: Dollar Limit Increase to the Term Contract for Replacement Wood Poles as Requested by the Parks, Recreation and Commercial Facilities Department (Mesa Contract #2007167) "Citywide" contract

Purpose and Recommendation

Council is requested to approve a Dollar Limit Increase to the Term Contract for Replacement Wood Poles as recommended.

The Business Services Department recommends increasing the dollar limit of the contract with Pacific Wood Preserving dba Nevada Wood Preserving by \$38,000.00 to \$132,957.44 for the remainder of the current contract period, based on estimated requirements.

Background/Discussion

The Parks, Recreation and Commercial Facilities Department has an urgent need to purchase 24 wood poles to replace existing ballfield light poles at parks and schools throughout the City. A recent inventory of the current poles was performed and it was found that these 24 poles have reached a critical point for replacement due to age and/or the condition of the wood.

These replacement poles will be purchased off the current contract, which provides wood poles for the Utilities Department, Electric Division, at the prices originally quoted in October 2007. The current Term Contract period is through January 31, 2010, with an option for one two-year renewal remaining.

Alternatives


Council may choose not to approve this increase and new bids will be obtained; however, a delay in purchasing these poles is not recommended as the integrity of these poles may compromise the safety conditions that exist in the parks and schools where the poles are installed.

Fiscal Impact

The total amount of \$38,000.00 is available in the Parks, Recreation and Commercial Facilities Department's budget.




