Subject: Purchase of Six (6) 764/800 MHz Portable Radios (Additions) and One Radio Deck for the Police Department's Fusion Center (City of Phoenix Contract #P-7288-05) (Fully Funded Arizona Department of Homeland Security Grant #2007-GE-T7-0006)
"Citywide" contract

Purpose and Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the Purchase of Six (6) 764/800 MHz Portable Radios and One Radio Deck as recommended. City of Phoenix contract pricing was evaluated by the Police and Business Services Departments.

The Business Services Department recommends authorizing purchase from the City of Phoenix contract with Motorola at \$32,332.75, including applicable sales tax.

Federal funds available from the 2007 State Homeland Security Grant Program (SHSGP) to the City of Phoenix, which must be used while the funding is made available or forfeited, will be utilized for this purchase. Mesa will purchase this equipment and Phoenix will reimburse the City with SHSGP funds.

Background/Discussion

This purchase will provide the Police Department's Fusion Center with six handheld radios and a multi-radio charging bank. The equipment will be utilized in the East Valley Fusion Center, hosted at the Mesa Police Department, which works high profile criminal related and counter-terrorism projects with Police Departments from the cities of Chandler, Tempe and Scottsdale, as well as the Town of Gilbert and the Salt River-Pima Maricopa Indian Community.

The radios will be housed in the charging bank at the Fusion Center and will allow Fusion Center Detectives and staff to have direct and immediate communication with each of the participating agencies during an active event or project.

Alternatives


Council may choose not to authorize purchase from the City of Phoenix contract and new proposals would be obtained; however, the use of the City of Phoenix contract provides Mesa with the most favorable pricing available in today's market.

Fiscal Impact


The total amount of \$32,332.75 is available from the 2007 Arizona Department of Homeland Security Grant Program through the City of Phoenix.
