Subject: Purchase of a Portable Digital Imaging System for the Mesa Police Department's Bomb Team (Mesa Contract #2008127) (Fully Funded UASI Federal Homeland Security Grant Program) (**Sole Source**) "Citywide" contract

Purpose and Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the Purchase of a Portable Digital Imaging System as recommended. Bid pricing was obtained and evaluated by the Police and Business Services Departments.

The Business Services Department recommends awarding the contract to the sole source bidder, Logos Imaging LLC at \$27,053.56, including applicable use tax.

Funding is available from the Homeland Security Grant Program, Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI), 2008 Rapid Response Team Sustainment Grant and must be used while the funding is made available or forfeited.

Background/Discussion

This purchase will provide a portable digital x-ray machine designed specifically to assist bomb team personnel in determining whether a suspicious package contains an explosive device or is harmless. Currently, the Police Department has two Rapid Response Teams available to respond to separate bomb/detection device incidents simultaneously. The Logos Imaging brand system is identical to equipment currently in use at the Police Department with components that are interchangeable. This technology, which will allow bomb technicians to look inside a package and examine it from a safe distance to make such determinations, will greatly enhance officer safety during explosive ordinance disposal (EOD) incidents.

Logos Imaging LLC is the manufacturer and sole source for this digital x-ray machine.

Alternatives

Council may choose not to award this contract and new bids will be obtained.

Fiscal Impact

The total amount of \$27,053.56 is available in the Police Department's budget through the Homeland Security Grant Program, Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI), 2008 Rapid Response Team Sustainment Grant (#444819-02).


