Recycle these items only in the blue barrel.



Plastic cups & containers

- ♻️ 1-7; now includes cups, margarine tubs and yogurt/plastic containers



Metal cans

- Food & beverage cans only



Milk & juice cartons



Cardboard & Paperboard

- Includes cereal, soda & other paperboard boxes
- Remove liners & any plastic wrap
- Break down large boxes



Glass bottles & jars

- Food & beverage containers only



Paper

- Includes computer/writing paper, junk mail, catalogs, phone books, newspaper, magazines & paper bags

Recycling Reminders

- Items should be relatively clean, dry and loose when placed into the blue barrel. NO plastic bags.
- Non-acceptable items include plastic bags, Styrofoam, diapers, napkins, tissues and plastic binders. These items slow down the sorting process.
* **Plastic bags can be recycled at your local grocery store.**
- Barrels should be in the gutter by 6 a.m. on scheduled collection day, including all holidays, and should be removed by 6 a.m. the day after service.
- When placed out for collection, keep barrels a minimum of 3' away from obstacles such as parked cars, light poles, mailboxes, planters, etc. and at least 18" away from other barrels.
- Do not place green yard waste in the blue barrel. The City of Mesa does offer a Green Barrel Program for this material. It is the only program of its kind in the entire state and is offered for a minimal monthly fee.
