Metso expands service capabilities with new facility in Arizona serving customers in southwestern USA and northern Mexico

Metso announced today the opening of a new industrial equipment repair and field service facility in Mesa, Arizona. This new operation is part of Metso's ongoing investment in regional service hubs located near customers to provide agility, excellence and quality in aftermarket service. The facility will serve customers in the mining, aggregates, and process industries throughout the southwestern USA and northern Mexico.

Located near the intersection of Pecos and Sossaman Roads in southeast Mesa, the new state-of-the-art facility features a combination machine, weld and mechanical rebuild shop. This innovative design allows more options to service the large-scale grinding mills, crushers, screens, pumps and other minerals processing equipment that make up Metso's broad base of installed equipment. The shop boasts a wide array of advanced equipment and machine tools, including 65-ton cranes, large diameter vertical boring mills, horizontal mills, lathes and welding equipment.

The Metso Mesa facility is currently staffed with approximately 65 professionals including shop personnel, administrative and support staff, health and safety experts, and technical support for both service and repairs. The facility is also home to a specialized field service team with experience servicing mines and industrial plants throughout the entire USA.

"Expanding our service capabilities is a key element of our business," says Kirk Smith, Vice President, Service Operations Hub – USA. "We strategically located our new service center in Mesa to better serve our growing customer base in the southwestern U.S. and northern Mexico. The new Mesa service center will enable us to offer services that help our customers maximize production capacity, increase plant availability, improve efficiency and reduce operating costs."

The facility adds to a growing list of Metso service centers on every continent around the world. Other such facilities include locations in Perth, Australia; Sorocaba, Brazil; Antofagasta, Chile; Cananea, Mexico; Tampere, Finland; Macon, France; Arequipa, Peru; Vereeniging, South Africa; Faridabad, India; Surabaya, Indonesia; with our next opening in Labrador City, Canada.

Official grand opening and open house event for the Mesa facility is scheduled for mid-September 2015. More details to be announced in advance of the confirmed date.
