



Clean Sweep/Green Sweep Application Process

Thank you for your interest in hosting a Clean Sweep/Green Sweep event in your area. The goal of this program is to assist Mesa residents in maintaining the cleanliness and beauty of their neighborhoods by providing them with a means to dispose of large amounts of trash and debris.

Clean Sweep/Green Sweep Request Process

1. Fill out the Clean Sweep/Green Sweep application packet and return to the City of Mesa Solid Waste Management Department.

Application Checklist:

- Have you included both the Roll-Off Agreement and Clean Sweep/Green Sweep Participant List?
- Have you enlisted the participation of at least 10 neighbors? Do all of them have City of Mesa barrel service?

Event dates will be scheduled on a first come, first serve basis and are subject to availability for your zone area.

2. Once your form is received, a City of Mesa Clean Sweep/Green Sweep Coordinator will contact you to schedule your event date as well as briefly review the logistics of the program and answer any questions you may have at that time.

3. Approximately 2 weeks prior to your event, you will receive informational Clean Sweep/Green Sweep packets along with a random number of customer survey cards to distribute. You will be asked to hand these packets out to each resident to inform them of the upcoming event and to let them know the types of items that may be placed into the containers.

4. Host your Clean Sweep/Green Sweep event. As the representative, you will need to maintain the area around each roll-off container(s) so that it is left free of debris once the roll-off container(s) is removed.

5. Evaluate your experience as the Neighborhood Contact and share your input as to how we can improve the program.

Your cooperation in monitoring the containers for proper usage is greatly appreciated. This allows us to continue to offer the Clean Sweep/Green Sweep program without additional costs, for the beautification of our Mesa neighborhoods.

I am the contact person for this event and accept fiscal responsibility for the coordinating of this neighborhood Clean Sweep/Green Sweep event. I have read all accompanying materials including the list of Acceptable/Non-Acceptable items as well as Solid Waste Solutions.

The participants requesting service shall hold the City of Mesa harmless from all claims by the homeowner(s) or any other party as a result of injury, damage to property or trespass.

The participants requesting the roll-off container(s) are responsible for the proper loading of the container(s). Contents must be distributed equally and level with the top of the container(s) to prevent possible damage to the property or City of Mesa equipment. Signs shall be posted to notify other residents of filled containers. Please contact the City of Mesa Clean Sweep Coordinator in the event that the container(s) become overfilled. In the event that the City of Mesa must level off or unload the container, the party requesting the container may be responsible for the charges typically associated with renting a roll-off container: \$129.00 per haul plus \$29.95 per ton (three ton minimum). A \$34.00 per ton fee may be assessed for all weight charges above 10 tons.

** For safety considerations, all boxes will be placed on the same side of the street.*

** Placement of containers is subject to final approval by Solid Waste Division to ensure that container location does not violate City code or compromise resident or employee safety. Example: Containers are not placed in high traffic areas, near stoplights, on cul-de-sacs, closer than 30 ft. away from stop signs, closer than 20 ft. away from a fire hydrant, etc.*
