BUILDING HISTORY



- 1950's - Originally built as a Grocery Store
- 1978 – Became the Arizona Museum for Youth
- 1996 – Built the Warehouse and Classroom Buildings
- 2002 – Expansion to Warehouse and Main Building
- 2009 – Interior Remodel
- 2014 – Rebranded as i.d.e.a. Museum
- 2025 – Completion of Phase 1 Renovations
- 2025 – Begin Phase 2 Renovations
