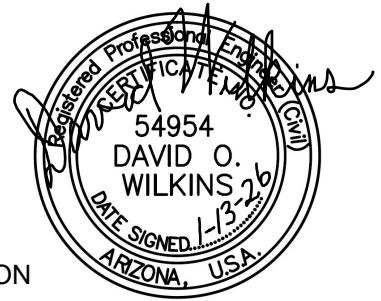

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed bids will be received until Thursday, February 12, 2026 at 1:00 p.m. All sealed bids will be received electronically at EngineeringBids@mesaaz.gov. Bids must be submitted as an unencrypted PDF attachment with a maximum size limit of 20MB. Any bid received after the time specified will be returned without any consideration.

This contract shall be for furnishing all labor, materials, transportation and services for the construction and/or installation of the following work:

The primary purpose of the Aripine Park and Whitman Park Playground renovation project is to provide/install new playground equipment at Aripine Park and replace the existing playground equipment at Whitman Park.

The scope of work for these two park locations may include the following:

- Removal of existing play equipment and dispose or salvage per the City's direction.
- Removal and Disposal of existing surfacing material.
- Installation of New Playground Surfacing. New Playground Surfacing Includes Engineered Wood Fiber (EWF) Loose Fill, Poured-IN-Place Seamless rubber play surfacing, and Sand, where Indicated on the Plans.
- 5-12 Year-old Play Area with play equipment
- 2-5 Year-old Play Area with play equipment
- Ninja Course Area with athletic equipment
- New Shade Structures with Lighting
- New ADA Ramps
- Sidewalk Modifications
- Installation of protection fence
- New in-ground mount Trash Receptacle
- New landscape benches

The Engineer's Estimate range is \$1,038,000 to \$1,270,000.
