

Cadet Program



This youth (15-18 years old) educational program provides an opportunity for participants to learn skills associated with the fire service. Cadets volunteer at community events.

Home Safety Education Program



Trained volunteers perform free home safety checks for Mesa residents. Volunteers install smoke alarms and perform a variety of other tasks to reduce the risks of fires and falls within a home.

Connector Program



Connector volunteers provide service to external and internal customers. They link residents to appropriate services and agencies in the community.

Community Emergency Response Team



Volunteers learn basic emergency response skills and can provide support to first responders during an emergency by immediately assisting their own family, friends, and neighbors. CERT members attend various community events promoting emergency preparedness and support departmental activities.

Special Event Volunteers



Volunteers provide assistance at a multitude of public events where our department presence is requested. Volunteer activities include: Information tables at health and safety expos, local school events, attending City of Mesa sponsored events, and canvassing of neighborhoods to distribute safety information or install smoke alarms.

Grief Support Team



Volunteers provide grief support to those who have just experienced the natural death of a loved one.

Social Service Team



Volunteers and interns from Arizona State University School of Social Work provide social service assessments and referrals to customers.
