

Temporary Traffic Control

Permits



The City of Mesa Transportation Department administers the Temporary Traffic Control (TTC) Program to better manage traffic restrictions on city streets. Managing these from a centralized team minimizes inconveniences and delays for drivers, bicyclists, and pedestrians.

The TTC Program requires advance review and approval of most street restrictions, provides for improved coordination among various entities working in the public right-of-way, and better oversight of temporary traffic control.

When is a TTC Permit Required?

- A permit must be obtained prior to any restriction (partial or full) of any street, sidewalk, alley, and bike lane within the City of Mesa right-of-way.
- This applies to all persons, contractors, utilities and other agencies (including City of Mesa departments).

Temporary Traffic Control Fees

Work involving temporary traffic control under the following types of permits are subject to permit fees:

- Right-of-Way (ROW) Permit
- Utility (UTL) Permit
- Capital Improvement Programs (CIP)
- City Maintenance Programs (CMP)
- Special Events

TTC fees must be paid prior to the issuance of a TTC Permit; fees are based on the number of days the permit holder plans to have restrictions in place. Each day or partial day that a restriction is in place is considered one restriction day.

Description of Road Impact	Fee
Minimum-No Restrictions Planned	\$50
Roadway/Alley Restriction	\$75 Per Day
Left Turn Prohibition –Signalized Intersection	\$50 Day Per Direction
Sidewalk Closure	\$20 Per Day
Arterial Road Closure	\$2,500 Per Day
Plan Review Fee (3rd and Subsequent Reviews)	\$50 Per Sheet/Review
Traffic Control Inspection Fee	\$90 Per Hour
Traffic Control Plan Review Fee (3rd and subsequent reviews)	\$50 Per Sheet and Review
