Notes:

1. FY 18/19 actuals reflect revenues as recorded in the financial system through September 10, 2019. FY 18/19 has not closed yet as local sales tax and state shared revenues are received in arrears. Additionally, sales tax accruals for sales activity between FY 18/19 and FY 19/20 have not been completed.
2. Projected Annual Growth for Urban Revenue Sharing (State Income Tax) is relatively high due to higher than anticipated personal income growth. Urban Revenue Sharing distributions are known amounts because they are determined by State personal income revenues received two fiscal years ago.
3. Other Revenues largely consists of building permits, civil and criminal fines, defensive driving class fees, and ambulance service fees.
4. FY 19/20 Projected shows a \$3.5M transfer into the General Fund for pay-as-you-go city infrastructure projects.
