

## Reclaimed Water Supplies



The City of Mesa reclaims approximately 40,000 acre-feet of effluent each year. A large portion of this is directly delivered to the Gila River Indian Community where it is used for agricultural purposes. In exchange, Mesa receives Colorado River water that is treated and delivered for potable uses within the City. This innovative exchange provides water security for both communities. Mesa also delivers reclaimed water for usage at the Palo Verde nuclear power plant and turf and crop irrigation.
